Apply for necessary permits		
► TIP Major improvements, such as wiring, plumbing, construction and demolition, usually require a permit. Be sure to check with your city.		
Set target completion date		
Get more than one quote		
▶ TIP Get all estimates in writing.		
Rule out any lead paint hazards for homes constructed before 1978		
Take "before" photos
