TIP: When placing your sink, the National Kitchen and Bath Association recommends at least 24" of countertop on one side of the sink and a minimum of 18" on the other.

Gourmet Cooking Station

You love to cook, and you prepare nearly all of your meals at home. From fresh vegetable omelets to three-course dinners featuring roasted duck breast with orange glaze, your kitchen runs on a full-time basis – which makes for plenty of clean-up. Be sure to put durable construction and plenty of room for dishes high on your wish list.



Features you might like:

- Look for at least one 10" deep bowl to accommodate large pots and pans.
- Heavier-gauge steel will provide long-lasting durability – the lower the number, the thicker the steel.
- Drain holes that are located closer to the rear of the sink maximize work space within the bowl.

TIP: Combining an undermount sink with a high-arc faucet will make it even easier to access the sink and clean awkward items such as baking sheets.

Gathering Space

You want a kitchen that allows you to stay connected to what's happening in other rooms of your home as well as a place where people gather to share conversation. Features you might like:

- For added convenience, consider adding a secondary sink to allow several people to work simultaneously. Or use your additional sink as a beverage center.
- Undermount sink installation provides a sleek, understated look that allows your countertops to shine.
- D-shaped bowls have a gently rounded shape that is easier to clean.

TIP: Controlling sound is important when your kitchen is open to adjacent rooms. Moen SoundSHIELD™ coating will dampen noise caused by dishes and vibrations.

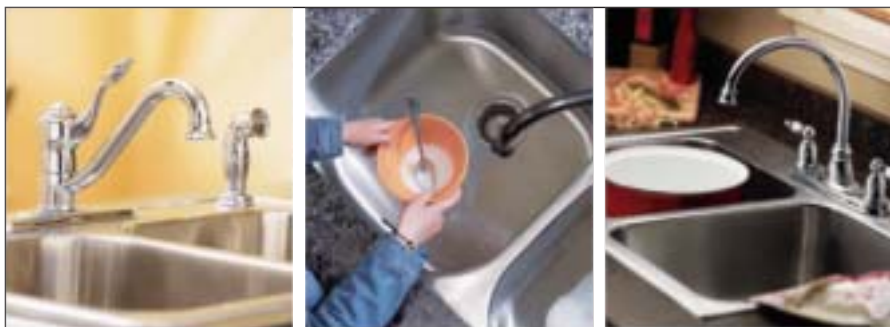

Compact Functionality

If you don't have an abundance of square feet in your kitchen, it's important to make the room work as efficiently as possible. When space is at a premium, even your choice of sink can help you keep things running smoothly. Think flexibility. Think in all dimensions. Size may be limited, but creative use of space is not.



Features you might like:

- Extra mounting holes can accommodate useful accessories such as a soap dispenser or instant hot water tap.
- Attach your garbage disposal to a shallow bowl to maintain maximum storage space in the cabinet below.
- Double bowls let you accomplish different tasks in one location (rinse veggies in one bowl, place dishes in other).

TIP: Keep in mind that a wide sink will reduce your available counter space. The National Kitchen and Bath Association recommends a linear total of 158" of countertop.

Budget-Minded Remodel

You want your kitchen to look great, but you have to stretch your budget to cover everything on your wish list. With Moen, you won't have to sacrifice quality to get a stainless steel sink you'll love for years.

Determine the mounting options on your sink.

- Faucets are measured by the distance between mounting holes, center-to-center.
- Most two-handle kitchen faucets are 8-inch centers, while bar faucets are 4-inch centers.
- If you chose a single-hole mount faucet, extra holes can be covered by a deckplate or used for accessories such as a soap/ lotion dispenser.
- Undermount sinks allow unlimited flexibility with faucet position.

Pullout spout provides easy access in and around the sink.



High-arc spout is perfect for filling large pots.

COMMON TERMS

Drop-In: An installation technique in which the sink lip lays on the top of the counter material. Also called self-rimming.

Gauge: A measurement of thickness, typically 18-gauge to 22-gauge. The lower the number, the thicker the steel.

Mounting Holes: The holes drilled into a sink used for attaching a faucet, side spray, soap dispenser. Sinks may include one, two, three or four holes. Some undermount sinks don't include holes because the holes are drilled into the counter onsite.

Undermount: An installation technique in which the sink is attached to the underside of a solid counter (granite or solid surface) using clips.

SoundSHIELD™: A state-of-the-art, sound-deadening material applied on Moen® stainless steel sinks. This dense undercoating material is precisely applied for exceptional noise reduction from the quiet dependability of Excalibur® to the whisper-quiet luxury of Lancelot® sinks.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

SITUATION	RECOMMENDED CLEANER	METHOD OF APPLICATION
Routine cleaning	Soap, ammonia, detergent and water	Rub with a sponge or cloth. Rinse with clean water and dry. Satisfactory for all finish types.
Smears and fingerprints	Window or glass cleaner	Rub with cloth. Satisfactory for all finish types.
Persistent spots and stains	Stainless steel cleaner	Apply with sponge or cloth. Rub back and forth in direction of grain lines. Rinse with clean water and dry. NOTE: Not for mirror finishes.
Hard water spots and scale	Vinegar (full strength)	Swab and soak for 5–10 minutes. Rub, then rinse with a neutralizer (such as a baking soda solution). Rinse with clean water and dry. Satisfactory for all finish types.
"Rusty" discoloration and atmospheric stains	Any of the above	Swab with a cloth and soak for 5 minutes. If necessary, rub with a nylon pad. Rinse with clean water and dry. Satisfactory for all finish types.

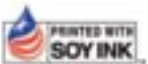
